## NOTICE OF RACE

OeSV EDV No 113314

### 1 Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the "Racing Rules of Sailing" (WRS).
- 1.2 In addition, the OeSV Racing Rules, the OeSV General Sailing Instructions, the supplementary UYC Mondsee Sailing Instructions and this announcement apply. Addendum UF in its latest version is applied.
- 1.3 Unless the class regulations prescribe something higher, ISO standard 124025 (or equivalent) shall apply as the minimum requirement for personal buoyancy aids. The use of inflatable buoyancy aids (automatic vests) is only permitted if this is expressly permitted in the applicable class regulations.
- 1.4 The provisions of the anti-doping regulations of World Sailing and the Federal Anti-Doping Act apply. Athletes who are suspended or banned due to doping, as well as support staff, are not permitted to participate in the event.
- 1.5 The use of remote-controlled aircraft (drones) over the regatta area by accompanying or supporting persons is - in addition to the legal provisions - only permitted if this has been registered with the organizer and approved by him.
- 1.6 Appendix T (Arbitration) will apply.
- 1.7 Appendix P (Direct Judging) will apply.
- 1.8 Appendix UF, Umpired Fleet Racing, will apply

## **2 Advertising**

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and provided by the organiser. Advertising by the participants is limited to clothing.

## **3 Eligibility and registration**

**3.1** Up to 18 teams will be eligible to enter.

**3.2** Boats will be provided to the competitors.

All races will be sailed on boats of the J70 class.

No changes may be made to the boats during the regatta or races. No additional fittings or equipment may be attached. Details regulate the general sailing instructions.

**3.3** The helmswomen and crew must be members of an association, individual member of the OeSV or another national association recognized by World Sailing.

**3.4** The helmswomen must be in possession of the OeSV junior regatta license or the Bfa-Binnen issued by the OeSV or a Lake Constance boatman's license or be able to present an equivalent document from a foreign association. Sailors in a team can be members of different sailing clubs.

**3.5** Registered boats that are eligible to participate by filling out the online form at [www.uyc-mondsee.at](http://www.uyc-mondsee.at) by the registration deadline and transferring the required registration fee.

**3.6** There is a minimum entry of 6 boats at the registration deadline. If this minimum number is not reached, the event can be cancelled. If the event is held and there are enough races, the title will be awarded regardless of the number of participants.

**3.7** A boat is only eligible to participate if it has completed the registration and all crew members have signed the liability waiver (liability, pictures, data).

## **5 Entry fee**

The entry fee per team is € 300,--. The entry fee has to be paid to UYC Mondsee, 5310 Mondsee, IBAN: AT15 4501 0301 0055 0000; BIC: VBOEATWWSAL

## **6 Deposit**

Each participating team must pay a deposit of EUR 500 (in cash or by credit card) at the beginning of the event. In case of a damage, the UYC Mo and the Austrian Sailing League jointly decide whether the deposit will be used to repair the damage.

## **7 Registration**

May, 26<sup>th</sup> 2023, 9.00 am – 4.00 pm in the UYC Mondsee race office:

Control of OeSV membership cards and sailing licenses as well as equivalent documents of foreign participants, issue of sailing instructions and signing of liability declarations.

## **8 First warning signal**

Saturday, May 27<sup>th</sup> 2023, 11 am.

## **9 Last warning signal**

On Monday, May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023, if the series is already valid, no warning signal will be given after 3:00 p.m.

## **10 Sailing instructions**

Sailing instructions are available at registration and are posted on the official notice board of the UYC Mondsee.

## **11 Pairing-List**

The groups and boats are divided by drawing lots. The order and number of races will be according to the pairing list established at the start of the event. The current pairing list will be announced on the first day of the race before the start of the race as part of the first briefing. It can be changed by the regatta management if teams do not appear or if boats drop out.

## **12 Training**

On Thursday, May, 25<sup>th</sup> 2023 and Friday, May 26<sup>th</sup> 2023, all boats have the opportunity to train according to a fixed schedule. The registration for the existing training slots takes place as part of the registration with a separate e-mail with the desired date and time to [christoph@skolaut.at](mailto:christoph@skolaut.at).

## **13 Regatta format**

The regatta will be sailed in umpired fleet race format.

## **14 Penalty System, Protests**

WRS Addendum UF (Rules for Umpired Fleet Racing) will apply. The relevant version of Addendum UF will be published in full in the Sailing Instructions.

## **15 Scoring**

The score of a participating crew is the sum of its individual scores according to the low-point system of Appendix A of the WRS without a discard.

## **16 Coach boats**

Use of private coach boats is not allowed.

## **17 Mooring, park area**

All boats must be parked in the assigned berths.

A separate parking area is available for parking trailers and cars. Campers or RVs cannot be parked.

## **18 Radio communication**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither transmit nor receive any voice or data while racing that is not available to all boats.

## **19 Prices**

Points prizes will be awarded to the top three teams. Each team present at the award ceremony will receive commemorative prizes.

## **20 Liability, pictures, data**

### **20.1 Liability**

By registering and/or participating, each participant undertakes to observe the racing rules of sailing, the rules of good, sporty seamanship, as well as all other rules applicable to this event and the association law of the sailing associations and the legal norms, and sails in accordance with rule 3 WRS and the acceptance this tender at your own risk.

The organizers/sponsors, their organs and assistants exclude any liability for damage - of whatever type and cause - on water and on land, for example those to the crew/team, the material and financial losses. This exclusion of liability applies to damage occurring before, during and after the event, but not (a) in the event of intent or gross negligence, (b) personal injury in the event of gross negligence, (c) personal injury if, as an exception, § 6 Para. 1 Z 9 KSchG should be applied .

To the same extent, each participant also waives their claims for damages against all persons who (a) are responsible for the implementation of the event (e.g. race director) or as referees and/or (b) the organizer at his request or order are helpful.

The participant bears the burden of proof for slight and grossly negligent fault for damage caused by unforeseeable and atypical dangers.

Liability for lost items or damage caused by third parties, as well as for unforeseeable or non-typical damage is also excluded.

#### **20.2 Recordings in image, video and sound**

By registering and/or participating, all participating persons agree that image, video and sound recordings of them and their boats/material will be made and these will be used for reporting on the event and for their - also future - application and promotion the purposes of the organizing clubs, may be published indefinitely.

#### **20.3 Data**

By registering and/or participating, all participants agree that personal data they have provided may be stored, used and passed on to higher-level sports organizations as part of the organizational implementation of the event.

#### **20.4 Minors**

In the case of underage participants, their declarations of intent must also be submitted by their legal representative or by a person specifically authorized in writing by the legal representative.

#### **20.5 Miscellaneous**

The organization of the event begins well in advance. A reimbursement of the registration fee or the travel costs is not planned. In exceptional cases and only to the extent that the organizer has saved something, the entry fee will be reimbursed; but not in cases of force majeure.

We reserve the right to make any necessary changes to the announcement and other rules (e.g. sailing instructions), but they will be announced in good time.

All prizes, in particular non-cash prizes and souvenir prizes, are forfeited if they are not collected personally at the award ceremony.

For questions that are not subject to the autonomy of the sport (association), the law of the Republic of Austria applies. The place of jurisdiction is the local and factual court responsible for Mondsee.

### **21 Insurance**

The boats are insured with the Austrian Sailing Association and the Austrian Sailing League Association.
